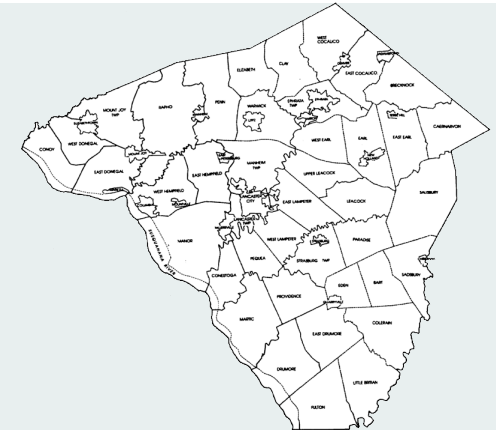

Class A Veteran Membership

To be eligible for membership in AMVETS, you must have served in the U.S. Armed Forces, including the National Guard and Reserves, any time after Sept. 15, 1940. Additionally, unless still serving, your discharge must have been under honorable conditions. If you served as an American citizen in the armed forces of an allied nation, under honorable conditions, between Sept. 15, 1940 and May 8, 1975, you are also eligible, as are wartime members of the Merchant Marine. Proof of eligibility can take the form of a DD-214, an honorable discharge certificate or other appropriate document.



Complete the Veteran Envelope for membership, place a copy of your DD214 and a check (payable to AMVETS Post19) for dues (currently \$36) and \$5 for a door card. (total \$41.00 currently for new members)

Post Meetings are held on the First (1st) Thursday of each month at 7:00PM

All Veteran members are welcome and encouraged to attend and get involved.



Ladies Auxiliary

Membership in AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary is open to the mothers, wives, widows, grandmothers, sisters, daughters and granddaughters of AMVETS and female veterans who are currently serving or who have honorably served in the Armed Forces of the United States, including the National Guard and Reserve components, anytime after September 15, 1940.

Complete an Application for Membership and enclose a check for \$35 (\$30 membership and \$5 door card fee) Applications are brought before the Auxiliary body for approval on the second (2nd) Thursday of each month.

SONS OF AMVETS

Eligibility for membership in the Sons of AMVETS shall be limited to all male descendants, grandsons, adopted sons and stepsons, fathers, husbands, widowers, and brothers of members of AMVETS and the deceased members of AMVETS, or the personnel who died and would have been eligible for membership in the parent organization, and are at least eighteen (18) years of age and is not eligible for membership in the parent organization. This is not to include in-laws of any type.

Complete Application for Membership with a check for \$45 (\$40 membership & \$5 door card fee)

Applications will be brought before the Son's Board Meeting for approval.

Rider Membership



Membership in the National AMVETS Riders shall be limited to members in good standing of AMVETS, AMVETS Ladies Auxiliary, and Sons of AMVETS. Members must be the legally registered owner of a motorcycle or be the spouse of the legally registered owner within the state of registration. Members must show for membership application a VALID State Drivers License with a Motorcycle endorsement, a VALID State Motorcycle Registration, and PROOF of insurance meeting State and Federal Regulations to the Chapter President and one other elected officer.

AMVET Riders Support members are also permitted. Support members must be a member of AMVETS, Ladies Auxiliary, or Sons of AMVETS. AMVETS Riders will recognize individuals who display a desire to help and support veterans through the AMVETS Riders Organization. You do not need to have a motorcycle to be a Support member and wear our vests.
